**BPA Gallery: “The Prints of Christmas”  
Screen printing and colored pencil by Denise Harris  
December @ Bainbridge Performing Arts (BPA)**

“**The Prints of Christmas**” features screen printing and colored pencil by **Denise Harris** at the BPA Gallery this December. The show comprises a series of prints given yearly to friends, commemorating the artist’s activities in a picture. Using Santa as a vehicle to express her visual perspective, the prints started as random ideas but quickly evolved into a visual diary representing each of the last 30 years. Studying each print gives the viewer an idea of how the year went — the good and the not-so-good. “Holy Toledo,” for example, was drawn while traveling in Spain; “Iconoclaus” came about during an excursion to Greece; and “Caravan of Caprice” involved Santa, a camel, and Egypt. The titles are integral to each print, helping to identify each object’s significance and find the year hidden within the image.

The exhibit appears at Bainbridge Performing Arts throughout December. The BPA Gallery showcases regional artists in monthly rotating exhibits in the C.
