Local artist Bridget Young performs new material entitled “Realtor Lady” based on her real life experiences as a local real estate agent. She reflects upon the inevitable joys, sorrows and hilarity that ensues while ushering people through the biggest financial transaction of their lives.

Bridget Young began writing the material for “Realtor Lady” several years ago as a way to decompress from the drama of being a full time realtor. Her first performances took place at the “Source” in the Admiral Theater in 2009; she has since performed in “12 Minutes Max” at On The Boards in Seattle and for local real estate events.

The show also features special musical guest PAUNDY — a six piece instrumental band that includes local musicians Paul Burbuck, Andy Miller, Tony Dattilo, Chad Channing, Drew McCabe, and Justine Jeanotte. Inspired by film/TV music as well as rock from the seventies and eighties, all of the band members are multi-instrumentalists and often trade instruments that include children’s toys for percussion. They have three self produced albums: Here’s Roebuck; Are you My Mother?; and In Through the Cat Door. They are known for their fun, upbeat live shows and will be touring Poland, Germany and the Netherlands in February.
