This winter, Bainbridge Performing Arts is pleased to offer an exciting array of classes for Pre-K/K, 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades, and adults at BPA, plus two delightful offerings for 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades at the Jewel Box Theatre in Poulsbo. **Imagination Station - Exploring Musical Theatre** is a six-week class for Pre-K/K held at BPA.
