West Sound Academy Sci-Fi Film Premiere: CHILDREN OF FIRE Saturday, January 15 @ 7:30 p.m.

CHILDREN OF FIRE is a short film created by the 7th–12th grade, fall semester, Film Production class at West Sound Academy (WSA) in Poulsbo. The Sci-Fi film premieres at Bainbridge Performing Arts (BPA) on January 15.

During the course of this three-month project, students explored the art of film creation from conception to production. They spent 48 classroom hours creating sets, costumes, acting and directing their very own 1950's style, black and white, science fiction drama. Written by Bainbridge Performing Art's Artistic Director **Steven Fogell**, the film was produced by WSA's Film Production Instructor **Thomas Hurley III**.
