Bainbridge Symphony Orchestra Auditions Wednesday, September 7, 2011 By appointment at Bainbridge Performing Arts (BPA)

The Bainbridge Symphony Orchestra is holding auditions for the 2011-2012 Season. All instruments are encouraged to audition, especially bassoon, trumpet, viola and basses. Auditions will be held on September 7, 2011 at Bainbridge Performing Arts (BPA), 200 Madison Avenue North, Bainbridge Island.

Those auditioning are requested to prepare two contrasting works displaying the depth of their musical sensitivity and range of technical ability. Participants may prepare solo material, etudes or excerpts, and should be prepared to play a total of five to eight minutes of music. Percussionists are asked to prepare solos or excerpts of their choice for snare drum, xylophone or glock, and an auxiliary instrument. Sight-reading for all instruments may be requested; music will be provided on site.

Interested parties are invited to call BSO Personnel Manager Patti Beasley at 206.842.6658 to arrange an audition time. Respondents are encouraged to download and complete the application at http://www.bainbridgeperformingarts.org/Symphony/documents/BSO_Application.pdf; copies will also be available at the audition site. Those auditioning are requested to arrive 15 minutes early and look for posted directions to the warm-up and audition rooms.
