Bainbridge Performing Arts (BPA) Announces Appointment of Interim Education Director / Front of House Manager Victoria Whitlow

Bainbridge Performing Arts is pleased to announce the appointment of **Victoria Whitlow**, who joins BPA this summer in a dual role as Interim Director of Education and Front of House Manager. Victoria comes fresh from her work at the 5th Avenue Theatre where she is a theatre teacher, performer, and where she was recently the children's supervisor for their production of *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*. As the Education Director of a program similar to BPA's in California, she developed curriculum for conservatory and outreach programs, adapted creative material for her classes, and earned the expressed support of her colleagues, her students, and their parents.

"We are incredibly fortunate to have had a wealth of candidates with creative and diverse skill sets. It's inspiring to see so much talent drawn to the arts," said BPA Interim Executive Director **Dominique Cantwell**, but given her overlapping skill set, Victoria clearly emerged as the best candidate for both jobs. Additionally, she will put her Disney PR training to good use in our box office when she assumes the Front of House role at the end of August."
