The BPA Gallery’s November exhibit features photography by BryAnn Bingham and metal/glass sculpture by Myorian Studio. Highlighting the Angeli that line the Ponte S’ Angelo, Bingham’s collection offers an invitation to Rome. Though challenged with capturing the intensity of such beauty with a camera, Bingham was powerless to keep her lens away. The Associate Director and a teacher at Bainbridge Dance Center, she is always looking for the next engaging image and is delighted with the array that shows up.

Dave Myers and Kelly Asadorian of Myorian Studio are interested in form, a focus that manifests itself in both lightness and strength in each piece. Their cut metal organic works are inspired by gardening and simple plant structures, as well as Japanese woodcuts and mid-century textiles. Line and flow are Myers’ major concerns, while color is Asadorian’s. Their glass and steel collaborations can be seen daily at their Winslow shop Ginger, around the island, and beyond.

“Angelic & Organic Forms” appears at Bainbridge Performing Arts throughout November. The BPA Gallery showcases regional artists in monthly rotating exhibits in the C. Keith Birkenfeld Lobby at BPA, 200 Madison Avenue North, Bainbridge Island. Admission is free, and gallery hours are 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Tuesday – Friday, plus one hour prior to each performance.
