Paintings by Betty-Ann Beaulieu and Cindy Heine
Join us for First Fridays Art Walk November 4 @ 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.**

Two women from Bainbridge Island display their eclectic artwork in watercolor, acrylic, and pen and ink media with “Bainbridge Women Expressions” this November at the BPA Gallery. **Betty-Ann Beaulieu’s** artwork has been described as “demonstrating elegant designs” of nature, and **Cindy Heine’s** paintings have been characterized as “whimsical” and “lighthearted.” Viewers will enjoy the impressionistic and abstract expressions of Bainbridge Island as well as travel images from across the country.

The collection of paintings opens with a public reception for the artists at the First Fridays Art Walk on November 4, from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m., at the BPA Gallery. Special music is provided by the **Impromptu Trio**, featuring Amy Duerr-Day (oboe), Barbara Deppe (cello), and Patricia Beasley (clarinet). Admission is free at 200 Madison Avenue North, Bainbridge Island. The exhibit hangs through the end of November. Works are available for purchase by arrangement with the artist. BPA Gallery hours are 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Tuesday – Friday, plus one hour prior to each performance.
