Join us for First Fridays Art Walk October 7 @ 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.

Stop by the BPA Gallery for a fun evening of art, food, and friends at the First Fridays Art Walk on October 7. Steven Fogell drew inspiration for this collection from the lush feeling of an antique French aviary and menagerie. Rich color palettes and texture fill each large canvas to create a feeling of movement and depth. He used acrylic paint, varnishes, vintage papers, gold and silver leafing for this work. “La beauté est naturelle...”

The exhibit runs concurrent with CATS, which opens October 14 and is directed by Steven Fogell. He will be returning to direct THE WOMEN at BPA in February 2012.

The collection of paintings opens with a public reception for the artist at the First Fridays Art Walk on October 7, from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m., at the BPA Gallery. Admission is free at 200 Madison Avenue North, Bainbridge Island. The exhibit hangs through the end of October. Works are available for purchase by arrangement with the artist.
