A fall series of four classes on early-dismissal days for 1st – 6th Grade
September 14, October 5, November 2, and December 7 @ 12:00 – 3:00 p.m.

When school lets out early this fall, come to BPA Theatre School's Clubhouse. BPA is now accepting registrations for a fall series of four classes on early-dismissal days in September, October, November, and December. First to sixth-grade students will see their Theatre School friends and teachers for lunch and enjoy a fun-filled, three-hour workshop focusing on specialized theatre skills and topics.

Clubhouse workshops include "Costumes, Make-up, and Movement," "Physical Comedy," "Raise your Voice," and "Theatre Olympics." Each workshop is designed to focus on a specific skill set or topic that will add depth to students' theatre education. All levels of experience are encouraged to attend. Tuition, \$120 per student, includes all four workshops and material fee.

Classes meet at BPA, 200 Madison Avenue North, Bainbridge Island on September 14, October 5, November 2, and December 7. Each workshop runs from 12:00 to 3:00 p.m., with doors opening at 11:00 a.m. for supervised lunch. Supervision is courtesy of BPA staff, however students must provide their own sack lunch.
